BEFORE WE GET STARTED, GOD WANTS ME TO TELL YOU SOMETHING:

"I love you with an everlasting love because you are a part of me. I created you and breathed life into your lungs. You are not an accident. I know everything about you... when you sit down, and when you stand up, when you laugh and when you cry. You are more important to me than you will ever know, and I have great plans for your future. I will never stop doing good to you. I am for you and never against you. I loved you so much that I sent my only son Jesus to be your savior. If you accept my son, nothing will ever separate you from my love, and you will live forever in Heaven with me. You are my special children and your names are stamped on my heart for all eternity." Did you know that Easter will be here in 3 weeks? Why do we celebrate Jesus at Easter time? When Jesus was suffering on the cross, do you think he was tempted to call down hundreds of angels to rescue Him? (maybe... but He knew he had to die for the sins of mankind. It was what His father wanted him to do. **HE DID NOT GIVE INTO TEMPTATION. HE DID NOT SIN.)**

- 1. What are some things that you are tempted by?
- 2. Do you ever give into temptation?
- 3. What about some things we should NEVER DO even when we feel like it? (Stealing, lying, hurting someone, cursing, etc.).

Today, we're going to hear the story of how satan tried to tempt Jesus to turn away from God.

When Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist at the age of 30, he became filled with the Holy Spirit, and God sent him immediately into the desert for 40 days and 40 nights. During that time, Jesus was not allowed to eat or drink ANYTHING. But that wasn't the worst of it! Jesus was tempted by satan when he was wandering in the desert ... he was starving for food and desperate for a sip of water and that's when satan approached him.

DO YOU KNOW ANYONE WHO COULD LAST EVEN 5 DAYS IN THE DESERT WITHOUT FOOD OR WATER? BUT JESUS SURVIVED 40 DAYS!!! HE WAS FULL OF THE POWER OF GOD AND WAS ABLE TO RESIST SATAN AND HIS LIES. Yes, he was tempted, BUT HE NEVER SINNED.

Jesus knows everything about you. He knows when you are tempted, and he knows how hard it is to resist temptation. He can help you when you are tempted to do something you know isn't right by staying close to Jesus. READ YOUR BIBLE EVERYDAY OR WATCH VIDEOS ABOUT BIBLE STORIES.

THE MORE JESUS YOU HAVE IN YOUR HEART, THE LESS YOU WILL BE TEMPTED TO SIN.

Thank You for creating everything we see!


Thank you for our families and our teachers. Thank You for the lives we live, and for making each person different.
