And the Walls Came Tumbling Down (Literally)

Dear Parents.

This lesson is about trusting God to tear down *walls* in our lives that keep us from the peace of God. The foundation of *my walls* are worry and/or regret, and I've discovered the more I fixate on the past or the future, the less peace I have. I'm working on trusting Jesus more every day. It's not always easy, but I definitely want the peace of God to rule my heart. And so if I trust Him more, my walls will come tumbling down, as they did in Jericho. BEFORE WE GET STARTED, GOD WANTS ME TO TELL YOU SOMETHING:

INTRODUCTION:

Have you ever heard the story of Jericho and how Joshua brought the walls down around the city? Well, after the Israelites survived 40 YEARS in the desert, God allowed them to enter the Promised Land (a land of beauty and wonderful things to eat), but their troubles were far from over. Joshua and God's army had to conquer many cities to remove the kings and soldiers that did not follow God. Jericho was the first of many cities they would have to overcome.

For older children, ask them to read JOSHUA 6:15-27

QUESTIONS:

- 1. Who was the woman who helped the Israelites conquer Jericho? (Rahab)
- **2.** Who was the man who stood in front of Joshua with a sword? (The Commander of the Lord's Army).
- 3. Who do you think sent the Commander? (God)
- **4.** What did the Commander tell Joshua to do? (to march around the gates for 6 days with his soldiers).
- 5. Was the Ark of the Covenant supposed to be carried by priests around the gates for 6 days as well? (Yes)
- 6. How many priests were told to walk around the gates blowing rams' horns for 6 days? (7)
- 7. How many times did they walk around the gates during those 6 days? (One time a day)
- **8. What happened on the 7th day?** (the soldiers and the priests walked around the gates 7 times then started SHOUTING AS LOUD AS THEY COULD.)
- **9. What happened next?** (the walls of Jericho came tumbling down!)

When the walls came down, the Israelites charged into the town and captured it. They were told to burn the city and everything in it. Only the things made of silver, gold and bronze and iron were saved. So the Lord was with Joshua, and his reputation spread across the Promised Land.

CONCLUSION: Every story in the Bible is written to teach us a lesson. In this story, God wants us to remember that life is not always smooth. Sometime we worry about things and feel like our problems are too big for God to solve. God is ALWAYS with us and hears all of our prayers. Continue to pray about your problems, and sooner or later, they will move out of your way, just like the walls of Jericho did for Joshua. **And always tell your parents about your problems so they can pray with you!**

Be strong and courageous.

Do not be afraid. Do not be dismayed.

For the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.
